A motion was made by Ms. Mozilo, seconded by Mr. Sutera and unanimously carried that the board of education, upon recommendation of the superintendent, approves probationary appointment of Christian Ranaudo, as assistant superintendent for curriculum and instruction, assigned to the district, effective on or about 8/16/10 with probation ending 8/15/13. Tenure Area: Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum and Instruction, compensation at \$144,000. (8-0)

A motion was made by Mr. Prokopchak, seconded by Mr. Cooper and unanimously carried that the board of education, upon recommendation of the superintendent, approves probationary appointment of Michael Gillespie, as director of personnel, assigned to the district, effective on or about 8/16/10 with probation ending 8/15/13. Tenure Area: Director of Personnel, compensation at \$128,000. (8-0)

A motion was made by Mr. Prokopchak, seconded by Ms. Mozilo and unanimously carried that the board of education, upon recommendation of the superintendent, approves the probationary appointment of Patrick Ryan, a custodial worker, assigned to the buildings and grounds department, effective ~~7/16/10~~ 7/19/10 with probation ending ~~7/15/11~~ 7/18/11. Step 1, compensation in accordance with the negotiated agreement between the CSEA and the BOE as listed, as amended.
